What is Wyoming's High Fidelity Wraparound Program?

Wyoming's High Fidelity Wraparound is an intensive voluntary care coordination process for youth aged 4 to 20 risking placement out of their home and community due to complex behavioral issues. High Fidelity Wraparound helps families and caregivers build support that meet their needs. The program allows young people to benefit from mental and physical healthcare, coordinating other interventions in their own communities while remaining safely at home, in school and out of trouble.

Wraparound provides specific interventions at critical steps in a family's journey towards recovery and stability. As a successful program, it has become a well-regarded model for children's mental health and recommended as a fiscally responsible strategy across the United States."






Economic growth and supporting small business

Wyoming's High Fidelity Wraparound program is continuously welcoming new providers into the network to meet the need of families. We provide an opportunity for small businesses to flourish in the regions where there is need.

To meet this need, Magellan Healthcare in Wyoming has supported approximately 35 small businesses across every region of Wyoming to offer High Fidelity Wraparound. Providers can choose to start their own business or become an employee of an established agency.

We believe that a highly qualified workforce with lived experience provides the best opportunities for families and providers to succeed. We invest in ongoing coaching and annual recertification for providers within the network at no cost to them.

Since 2015, over 2,000 youth and families have participated in the program. Those who qualify have the opportunity to rely on their lived experience and become providers to support others to do the same.
